RULES

- **SSI 1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
 - 1.2 The series will be governed by:
 - 1.2.1 The rules as they apply to IRC and PHRF handicapping methods
 - 1.2.2 The Notice of Race (except as changed by the Sailing Instructions)
 - 1.2.3 The Sailing Instructions
- 1.3 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 2, Category 4 will apply
- **1.4** The Racing Rules will be modified in accordance with rule 86 as follows:
 - 1.4.1 Rules of RRS Part 2 will be altered during the race between the hours of official sunset and sunrise to give precedence to the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.
 - 1.4.2 RRS 52, Manual Power, shall not apply
- 1.5 Each competing Yacht is required to use the PredictWind GPS tracking service as per NoR 19

AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

SSI 8 The following fairway marks are to be passed on the main navigation side of the channel.

- 8.1.1 Green Sandspit Beacon Keep south of. Approx 36deg50.00S & 174deg48.43E
- 8.1.2 Orakei Sewer Outlet Beacon Keep north of Doris Rock Beacon (if in place) & Bean Rock Lighthouse Keep north of FI (3) WR. 8s 15m 14/11M Approx 36deg50.02S & 174deg49.86E
- 8.1.3 Rangitoto Lighthouse Keep west of Fl. R. 12s 21m 7M Approx 36deg46.939S & 174deg49.320E
- 8.1.4 Illiomana Rock Beacon Keep south of Q. WR 2m 5/3M Approx 36deg48.506S & 174deg53.185E
- 8.1.5 Devonport Cable Marks Keep south of Browns Island Beacon Keep north of FI WR 4s 1010m 6/6M Approx 36deg49.45S & 174deg53.94E Bastion Buoy Keep north of Emu Rock Marker Keep south of 36deg47.82S & 174deg54.93E
- 8.1.6 Red Buoys off east side of Motuihe Channel Keep north of FI (2) R.5s Approx 36deg47S & 175deg55E
- 8.2 All Latitude and Longitudes are approximate only
- 8.3 Boats while racing shall pass on the main navigational channel side of all mooring buoys and moored boats in or adjacent to the designated mooring areas shown on chart NZ5322. These areas shall be treated as an obstruction. Boats while racing shall not sail south of a line being an extension of the permanent wave-break at Okahu Bay.

THE START

- SSI 9 For Race 1 Richmond Yacht Club Spring Regatta refer RYC NOR & SI
- 9.1 For Races 2 5 the start line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a committee boat anchored in the area adjacent to Orakei Wharf and an orange laid mark or, in the absence of a laid mark, the Orakei Yellow Buoy.
- **9.2** Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area.
- **9.3** Boats starting later than 30 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes rule A4.1

THE FINISH

SSI 10 For Race 1 Richmond Yacht Club Spring Regatta refer RYC NOR & SI

- 10.1 For Races 2 5 the finish line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on a committee boat anchored in the area adjacent to Orakei Wharf and the Orakei Yellow Buoy. In the absence of a committee boat the finish line will be between the Royal Akarana Yacht Club and the Orakei Yellow Buoy.
- **10.2** Finishing boats must cross the line in a westerly direction.
- 10.3 It is the responsibility of each boat to ensure it is properly identified. Finishing boats shall contact the Gold Cup Race Committee when approaching the line.

RADIO COMMUNICATION

- **SSI 11** Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 11.1 The Race Channel will be VHF 17 unless the Race Officer advises otherwise.
- 11.2 Prestart Check-in: All boats shall contact the Gold Cup Race Committee up to 30 minutes prior to your divisions warning signal and advise Boat name, sail number and number of persons on board.
- 11.3 Pre-finish Check-in: All boats shall contact the Gold Cup Race Committee up to 30 minutes prior to finishing and advise Boat name and sail number.
- **11.4** A boat that retires from a race shall notify the Gold Cup Race Committee on VHF 17 or tel: 02102314559.
- **11.5** Race 5 Balokovic Cup Check-in: Boats shall give radio position reports to Coast Guard for Race 5 as described in Attachment 5.

PENALTY SYSTEM

A boat which, after the warning signal, crosses the start line and fails to return to the pre-start side of the line will be penalized 20 minutes on elapsed time. This changes rules 29 and A4.2
