

# **RAYC Team Selection Process**

The Royal Akarana Yacht Club (RAYC) is committed to providing fair, transparent and values-based opportunities for sailors to represent the club at regattas.

### 1. Expression of Interest

All eligible sailors will be invited to submit an expression of interest when team opportunities arise.

- EOIs will be open to all active sailors within a relevant class or discipline.
- Submission details and closing dates will be clearly communicated through RAYC channels.

## 2. Selection Panel

Team selection decisions will be made by a delegated sub-committee of the Sailing Committee. This group may include coaches, members of RAYC staff, class representatives and sailing committee members to ensure fairness and consistency.

#### 3. Selection Framework

Before each selection process begins, the Sailing Committee will confirm and communicate the specific criteria relevant to that even. These will include both general eligibility requirements and performance-based selection criteria.

## A. General Eligibility

To be considered for selection, sailors must:

- Be a **current, paid-up member** of the Royal Akarana Yacht Club.
- Represent RAYC at regattas and in their sailing activities, including consistently racing under the RAYC burgee.
- **Demonstrate RAYC values** sportsmanship, respect and commitment to the club.

# **B. Specific Criteria**

Once eligibility is confirmed, the selection panel will consider:

- Results, performance & experience in relevant class or regattas.
- Level of RAYC representation and contribution to club activities.
- Additional criteria specific to the event (e.g. age, gender balance, training attendance).

### 4. Communication

Following the decision process, selected sailors will be notified directly, and team announcements will be made publicly once confirmed. Feedback may be provided upon request.
